This clover likes to grow with white sweet clover. They are very similar but Yellow Blossom Sweet Clover is softer. This clover is valuable for honey production as honeybees relish it. This clover provides great habitat for Pheasants and Quail chicks through its ability to attract soft bodied insects during the peak of the Pheasant hatch. In good growing conditions, Yellow Blossom Sweet Clover can grow 3-4 feet high.

PLANTING TIPS

- Ideal planting time is from Aug-Sept or Dec-March
- Plant the seed 1/4-1/2 inches deep
- To achieve the best nitrogen fixing results, it is important to inoculant the seed
